THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2011

(Report of the Subject Committee)

Subject Committee XIV—Home Affairs to which the Payment of Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Bill, 2011 was referred, considered the Bill clause by clause and now submits this report with the Bill as reported by the Committee annexed thereto.

- 2. The Payment of Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Bill, 2011 was published as a Gazette Extraordinary dated October 15, 2011. The Bill was introduced in the Assembly on October 27, 2011 and was referred to the Committee on the same day.
- 3. The Committee considered the Bill clause by clause at its meeting held on March 20, 2012 and the Committee recommends to adopt the Bill with the following modifications, namely:—

In clause 2 of the Bill,—

- (i) The existing provision shall be numbered as sub-clause (1) and in the sub-clause (1) as so numbered, for the words "other than a member of an All India Service," the words "below the rank equivalent to an Under Secretary to the Government and" shall be substituted;
- (ii) after sub-clause (1) as so numbered, the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely:—
- "(2) after sub-section (6) the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

"Provided that such an officer may be allowed to continue in the service of the member even after his promotion to the rank equivalent to an Under Secretary to Government and above.".

4. The other changes made in the Bill are consequential.

further to amend the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951.

Preamble.—Whereas, it is expedient further to amend the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India, as follows:

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Payment of Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Act, 2012.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 8A.—In section 8A of the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 (XIV of 1951),—
- (1) in sub-section (6), for the words "not above the rank of a Selection Grade Assistant in the Government Secretariat and", the words, "below the rank equivalent to an Under Secretary to the Government and," shall be substituted.
- (2) after sub-section (6) the following proviso shall be inserted namely:—

"Provided that such an officer may be allowed to continue in the service of the member even after his promotion to the rank equivalent to an Under Secretary to Government and above."
