As per the Government Order read as first paper above, the Action Plan for utilisation of 13th Finance Commission Award for an outlay of \$\circ{2}\) 49.50 Crore for 2011-12 and the perspective year wise Action Plan for \$\circ{2}\) 198 Crore for the period 2011-2015 was approved as agreed to by the SLEC Meeting on 13th Finance Commission Award, Accordingly, the outlay fixed for Health Infrastructure for 2011-12 under 13th Finance Commission Award was accommodated under various Heads of Account in the Annual Plan Budget for 2011-12. As per the approved Action Plan \$\circ{2}\) 4.25 Crore is carmarked for setting up of Poly trauma care facilities including Mortuary in Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram and the amount was provided under the H/A "2210-05-105-15-01(P)-Development of Medical Colleges under DME (13th Finance Commission Award)" in the current years Budget.

2. As per letter read as third paper above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted proposal seeking Administrative Sanction for the first phase construction of the multi-storied building for providing facilities for Poly Trauma care, Geriatrics, Cardiology, CVTS and Mortuary in Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram at an estimated cost of ₹ 10.25 Grore by meeting the expenditure of ₹ 4.25 Grore under the head of account "2210-05-105-15-01(P)-Development of Medical College. Thiruvananthapuram(13th Finance Commission Award)" provided in the Annual Plan Budget 2011-12, ₹ 1 Grore from Grant-in-aid from Government of India sanctioned during 2011-12, for the conduction of National Programme for the Care of Elderly (NPHCE) and the remaining amount of ₹ 5 Grore from the HDS Fund. - 2) The Director of Medical Education as per letter referred above had submitted a detailed proposal for the commencement of Emergency Critical Care Departments in the five Government Medical Colleges of the State and Strengthening of supporting facilities, at a cost of Rs. 1397 lakks per institution and a total cost of Rs. 70 Crores (Rupees Seventy Crores only) for setting-up Emergency Critical Care Departments in the five Government Medical Colleges of the State.
- 3) Government have examined the proposal in detail and considering the current financial constraint, Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the commencement of Emergency Critical Care Departments in Government Medical Colleges at Alappuzha. Kottayam and Thrissur at a cost of Rs. 1397 lakhs each per institution (as per details attached

as afmexure). Administrative sanction is also accorded for setting Emergency Critical Care Departments in Government Medical Colleg Thiruvananthapuram under the Poly Trauma scheme and in Governmen Medical College, Kozhikode under the Pradhan Manthri Swasthya Surakha Yojana (PMSSY).

As per Government Order read as 1st and 2nd paper above Government have accorded administrative sanction for the 1st and 2nd Phase of the construction of Multistoried building in Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram for the Multi Disciplinary ICU, Poly Trauma and other facilities amounting to Rs.10.25 Cr and Rs.11.35Cr(Total Estimate -Rs.21.6 crores). Funds amounting to Rs.13.75Cr were released by utilising the allocation under 13th FC and NPHCE. As per the G.O read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above, revised administrative sanction was accorded for the construction of House Surgeons Quarters in Medical College ,Thiruvananthapuram at an estimated cost of Rs.439 Lakhs . Rs.109.75 Lakhs was already released to the implementing agency during 2011-12, by meeting the expenditure under the Plan Scheme "Matching Grant for PMSSY-Thiruvananthapuram". As per the G.O administrative sanction was also accorded for the construction of access road to Poly Trauma Building in Medical College Thiruvananthapuram at an estimated cost of Rs.88 Lakhs.

As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, Government have authorized additional expenditure of Rs.1202.25 Lakhs under the Plan Scheme "Allopathy Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram", in the Head of Account "2210-05-105-98-34-OC(P)". The additional expenditure was authorized for the balance fund of the aforesaid works entrusted with HLL at Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. The Principal Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram has reported that HLL has completed the works of construction of Multi Disciplinary ICU, Poly Trauma and House Surgeons Quarters and requested for release of payment. The Principal has also requested

permission to deposit Rs.88 Lakhs with HLL for the construction of " access to Poly Trauma Building".

- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail and to accord sanction to make an amount of 1131.85 Lakhs by debiting the expenditure under the Head of Account "2210-05-105-98-34-OC (P) from the Current year's budget provision for releasing the balance fund to HLL Life Care Ltd, for the consruction of the works subject to the following conditions.
- i) The balance payment of Rs.785 Lakhs and Rs.329.25 Lakhs in respect of the first two works shall be released to HLL, subject to the amount permitted by the technical committee after the scrutiny of the works /claims in respect of works and also after deducting the retention amount of 5% of executed value of work as prescribed in Government Order read as 4th paper above. In the case of 3th work viz Construction of access road to Poly Taruma Building an amount of 17.6 Lakhs shall be deposited with HLL. The balance amount shall be released as in accordance with the provisions of Government Order read as 4th paper above. Full amount shall not be released without completing the work.



Five Crore and Fifty Lakh Only) under the Head of Account "2210-05-105-98-34-3-OC (P) for meeting the expenses towards the Operation & Maintenance of Multi Specialty Block of Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram

2. Now the Director of Medical Education has submitted a proposal seeking Administrative Sanction for utilising an amount of Rs. 5,50,00,000/-, sanctioned vide Government order read above, for the Development of Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram & Commissioning of Multi Specialty Block by meeting the expenditure from the provision under Head of account '2210-05-105-98-34-3-OC. The proposal includes outsourcing man power for O&M of Multi-Speciality Block, Execution of AMC/ CAMC for major installations, Purchase & installation of Medical Grade Air Compressor unit with dryer and filter system, pending payment to M/s. HLL towards the civil works and installation of Mortuary Cold chamber, vertical expansion of main hospital buildings above ward 5 & 7. The Director has also informed that a proposal for post creation (27 categories) is under consideration of Government which does not include certain Non-Medical /Technical staff required for the Operation of the major installations. Adequate supporting staff are also required for Multi- Specialty Block until sufficient posts are created. Accordingly, Director has informed that an amount of Rs.4,66,65,954.77/-is required for outsourcing 16 categories of posts for a period of One year and the anticipated expenditure for the remaining period of the

current financial year is Rs 40,00,000/. Considering the exigency, the Director also requested to accord Administrative Sanction for the aforesaid proposal at the earliest.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs. 5,50,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crore and Fifty Lakh Only) sanctioned vide Government order read above, for the Development of Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram & Commissioning of Multi Specialty Block, as detailed below, by meeting the expenditure from the provision under Head of account '2210-05-105-98-34-3-OC during current year (2017-18).
