O R D E R

In the G.O. read above, a Committee of experts was constituted to study the present Organisational Structure of the State Planning Board and to suggest measures for rationalisation. The Committee submitted its report in August 1990, recommending reduction in the ten existing technical divisions in the Planning Board. Three posts of Chiefs viz; Chief Transport, Chief Industries and Chief Data Bank and Computer Division in the Board were abolished as per G.O. 3rd read above in connection with the review of the staff strength. Government after careful examination of the report, order that the State Planning Board will be re-organised with the following seven technical divisions:

1. Plan Co-ordination Division
2. Perspective Planning Division
3. Evaluation Division
4. Agriculture Division
5. Industry & Infrastructure Division
6. Social Service Division
7. Decentralised Planning Division.

On re-organisation the present seven division heads will be re-designated as shown below:-

The technical Staff of the present ten divisions will be brought under the above seven divisions, The Member Secretary, State Planning Board will issue necessary orders regarding re-distribution of the staff.

The posts of Market Analyst and Engineer will be kept in abeyance till the end of the 8th plan period.

The re-organisation will be subject to the condition that there will be no additional financial commitment to Government.

THE KERALA STATE PLANNING SERVICE

S.R.O.No.11/75.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala State Planning Service.

RULES

No. 1436/85.— In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Kerala State Planning Service Published under notification G. O. (P) No. 57/74/Plg. dated 13th December, 1974, as S. R. O. No. 11/75 in Part I of the Kerala Gazette No. I dated the 7th January, as subsequently amended, namely:—

Tribes, Other Backward Classes and not already in the Service of Government shall be eligible for relaxation of age limit as provided in sub-rule (c) of rule 10 of part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 subject to the specific condition that the upper age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years.
