ORDER

Vide Order read as 1st paper above the District Development Council (DDC) in all the districts in the State was reconstituted with the following members.

Vide letter read as 2nd paper above, Govt. have allowed Vice President of District Panchayat to attend the DDC meetings. As per Para 4 of the GO read as 3rd above, sanction was accorded to continue the present system of DDC which includes representatives of Local Self Govt. and to strengthen the functioning of DDC in order to ensure effective monitoring of all schemes.

The District Collector, Pathanamthitta vide paper read 4th above has sought for clarifications as to which representatives of Local Self Govt. are to be included in the DDC.

ORDER

1. District Development Council (DDC) is functioning in the State from 22.06.1997 (proceedings No. H 17321/56/PL.GP) dated 22.06.1997. Its constitution functions etc have impact on the holistic development of the District. Vide G.O (P) No. 167/83/Plg dated 18/03/1993, DDC is reconstituted with District Collector as Chairman and all MPs, MLAs and District heads of all Development Departments, representatives of Lead Bank etc as Members. Issues pertaining to the implementation of schemes and projects in the district are examined in the DDC. This helps the district administration to tackle the issues (financial, field level co-ordination etc) which influence the development of any region in the district.

2. When the DDCs were formed, the Local Self Government Institutions were not in existence in the State. Vid: G.O. (P) No. 37/80/Pg dtd 12.09.1980, the Chairman of Municipalities, Mayor of Corporation and representatives from Panchayats were included in the DDC. Later as per 74th amendment to the Constitution, the District Planning Committee (DPC) came into existence and the three Local Self-Government Institutions started functioning as development agencies. Hence the formulation of plans pertaining to local bodies grants were examined at DDC. But the issues related to the implementation, monitoring etc of all development schemes in the District are effectively discussed in the DDC. Recently, Government have decided to invite the Vice President of the District Panchayat also to the DDC meeting. This is a high level forum available in the District to periodically review all the development activities and take up any issues which require the attention of Government.

3. The Fourth State Finance Commission in its Report in para 17.71 of Part II has recommended to wind up the DDC and to make the DPC the authority for monitoring the implementation of State Plan Schemes at the District and bring about appropriate

The Government is considering the matter in detail and in supervision in the

Schemes, State Plan Schemes, Decentralized Plans, MFLAIS, MLASDF, etc.).
