

S. R. O. No. 166/2019.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Kerala Education Act, 1958 (6 of 1959), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Education Rules, 1959, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Education (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th day of January, 2016.

2. *Amendment of the rules.*—In the Kerala Education Rules, 1959,—

(a) in Chapter XXI, in rule 7,—

(i) in sub-rule (1), for the words, “The posts of Lower Primary School Assistant”, the words, figures and letters “Subject to rules 43, 51A and 51B of Chapter XIV A the post of Lower Primary School Assistant” shall be inserted;

(ii) in sub-rule (2), for the words, “The additional posts”, the words, figures and letters, “Subject to rules 43, 51A and 51B of Chapter XIV A the additional posts” shall be inserted;

(iii) for sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule and the Note shall be substituted, namely:—

“(3) (a) Subject to rules 43, 51A and 51B of Chapter XIV A, in the schools opened or upgraded during the period from 22nd May, 1979 to 28th January, 2016, except in the pre-upgraded section, in addition to the additional posts or vacancies earmarked for appointing protected hands in terms of sub rules (1), (2) and (4), one among the existing or arising regular vacancies of teachers or non teaching staff shall also be filled up by the Manager by appointing a protected hand from the Teachers Bank with the permission of the Deputy Director, Education concerned.

(b) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (viii) of rules 6, Chapter V, in the schools opened or upgraded or opening or upgrading on or after 29th January, 2016, except in the pre-upgraded section, all the existing and arising vacancies including all additional or new posts shall be filled up by the Manager by appointing protected hand from the Teachers Bank with the permission of the Deputy Director, Education concerned.

*Note:*—“Pre-upgraded section” means the existing Lower Primary or Upper Primary section prior to the upgradation of the school as Upper Primary School or High School on or after 22nd May, 1979.”

(iv) for sub-rule (5), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(5) Subject to rules 43, 51A and 51B of Chapter XIV A, the posts or vacancies earmarked for appointing protected hands in sub-rules (1), (2), clauses (a) and (b) of sub-rule (3) and sub-rule (4) shall not be filled up by the Managers otherwise than from the Teachers Bank. The appointments made by the Managers against other vacancies occurred on the same date or on a subsequent date, shall be considered for approval only with effect from the date of joining duty of the protected hands in the above posts or vacancies.”

(v) in sub-rule (8), for the figures, brackets and words, “(1) and (2)”, occurring in both the places, the figures, brackets and words, “(1), (2) and clauses (a) and (b) of sub-rule (3)” shall be substituted.

(b) in Chapter XXIII, in rule 14 A,—

(i) the words “and in rule 3A of Chapter XXIV B” shall be omitted;

(ii) for the words “notification in the official gazette”, the word “order” shall be substituted.

### Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

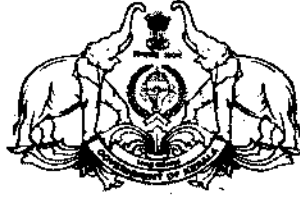
As per G. O. (P) No. 199/2016/G.Edn. dated 3rd December, 2016, and published as S. R. O. No. 752/2016 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2151 dated 14th December, 2016 Government have amended the Kerala Education Rules, 1959 thereby providing provisions for appointing teachers from among the list of protected teachers maintained under the Teachers Bank. As a part of it, all vacancies in the schools opened or upgraded on or after 22nd May, 1979, except in the pre-upgraded sections were earmarked for appointing protected teachers from the Teachers Bank. It has now been

decided that, in the schools opened or upgraded during the period from 22-5-1979 to 28-1-2016, except in the pre-upgraded section, in addition to the filling up of additional vacancies mentioned in Rules 7(1), 7(2), 7(4) Chapter 21, one among the existing or arising regular vacancies shall also be filled up by appointing protected hands from the Teachers Bank. Regarding the schools opened or upgraded or opening or upgrading on or after 29-1-2016, all the existing or arising vacancies are decided to be filled up by appointing protected hands from the Teachers Bank. Government also intends to protect the interests of rules 43, 51A and 51B claimants in the matter of appointing teachers in the posts of Lower Primary School Assistant or Upper Primary School Assistant sanctioned additionally by exempting Headmasters from class charges and in the additional posts. Government have also decided to extend the strength of staffs sanctioned in the schools for the last year to subsequent year or years by way of a Government Order, thereby substituting the need for issuing a notification in the Official Gazette for the purpose by amending rule 14A of Chapter XXIII of the said Rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above objects.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Kerala Education Act, 1958 (Act 6 of 1959) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Rules further to amend the Kerala Education Rules, 1959, namely:—



## RULES

1. Short title and commencement (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Education (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st May, 2019.

2. *Amendment of the Rules*.—In the Kerala Education Rules, 1959,—

(1) in Chapter I, in rule 2,—

(i) in sub-rule (3), before the word "Education" the word "General" shall be inserted;

(ii) for sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"(4) Director" means Director of General Education;"

(iii) in sub-rule (5), after the words "Assistant Educational Officer", the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted

(iv) in sub-rule 7(a), after the word "Headmaster", the symbols and words "Headmistress, Vice-Principal and Principal" shall be inserted;

(v) after sub-rule (8), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

"(8a) Vice-Principal means the teacher who acts as the academic head of Standards I to X in schools having standards I to XII."

(2) in Chapter III.—

(i) in rule 4,—

(a) in sub-rule (2), for the words "Director of Public Instruction", the word "Director" shall be substituted;

(b) in sub-rule (4), for the words "Director of Public Instruction", the word, "Director" shall be substituted;

(ii) in rule 7, in clause (b) of sub-rule (4), after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal" shall be inserted;

(iii) in rule 8, in the first and second provisos to sub-rule (1), after the word "Headmaster/s" the words "or Headmistress/s or Vice-Principal/s" shall be inserted;

(iv) in rule 9 —

(a) in sub-rule (2), after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(b) in sub-rule (4) after the word "Headmaster" the words "Headmistress or Vice-Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(3) in Chapter IV,—

(i) in the schedule to sub-rule (1) of rule 5, in column (2) "Accommodation required", against the words "Secondary School (High and Higher Secondary Schools)", in the column after the word "Headmaster's", the words and symbol "or Headmistress's or Vice-Principal's and Principal's" shall be inserted;





(ii) in the Explanation to rule 15, after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(iii) in sub-rule (2) of rule 16, after the word "Headmistress" occurring in both the places, the words "or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(4) in chapter VI,—

(i) (a) in rules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 14, 15, 17, 18 and 22A, after the word "Headmaster" wherever it occurs, the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(b) in rule 20, after the word "Headmaster's" the word or Headmistress's or Vice-Principal's or Principal's as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(ii) in rule 10 A the words "or the Joint Director" shall be omitted;

(5) in Chapter VII,—

(i) in sub-rule (2) of rule 4, sub-rule (1) of rule 9, clause (c) of rule 9A and rule 10, after the word "Headmaster" wherever it occurs, the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(ii) in sub-rule (2A) of rule 4, after the word "Headmaster" the words and symbols "Headmistress, Vice-Principal, Principal" shall be inserted;

(6) in Chapter VIII,—

(i) in rules 2, 11 & 13, after the word "Headmasters" wherever it occurs, the words "or Headmistresses or Vice-Principals or Principals" shall be inserted;

(7) in Chapter IX,—

(i) in sub-rule 2, of rule 3 after the word "Headmaster" the words and symbols "Headmistress, Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(ii) in rule 6, in sub-rule (1),—

(a) for the word "Headmaster" wherever it occurs, the words and symbols "Headmaster, Headmistress, Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be substituted;

(b) for numeral "X", numeral "XII" shall be substituted;

(iii) after rule 15, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

"15A General supervision.—Subject to the powers, duties and functions vested with the Headmaster/Vice-Principal under rule 10, 11, 13, 14 and 15 in schools having standards I to XII the General supervision of such schools shall vest with the Principal of the school;"



(8) in Chapter XI, in rules 1 and 2, after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal" shall be inserted;

(9) in Chapter XII,—

(i) in rule 2, in clause (b) of sub-rule (1), for the numerals and words "X or XI", the numerals, symbol and word "X, XI or XII" shall be substituted;

(ii) in rule 12, after the word "Headmaster", the words "Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(10) in Chapter XIII,—in clause (v), after the word "Headmaster", the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal" shall be inserted;

(11) in Chapter XIV (A),—

(i) in sub-rule (1) of rule 1 and sub-rule (5) of rule 10, for the words "Director of Public Instruction" the word "Director" shall be substituted;

(ii) in clauses (a), (b) and (c) of rule 14(A), after the word "Headmaster" wherever it occurs, the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal" shall be inserted;

(iii) in rule 15, for the words "by the Headmaster under orders from the manager and the Headmaster" the words "by the Headmaster or Headmistress or Vice-Principal in the case of teachers of schools having standards I to X and by the Principal in the case of teachers of standards XI and XII under orders from the manager and the Headmaster or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be substituted;

(iv) in rule 16, after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal in the case of teachers of schools having standards I to X and by the Principal in the case of teachers in standards XI and XII" shall be inserted;

(v) in rule 17, for the words "When a Headmaster or a teacher deputed to be in charge of the duties of Headmaster" the words and symbols "When a Headmaster, Headmistress, Vice-Principal or a teacher deputed to be in charge of the duties of Headmaster, Headmistress or Vice-Principal as the case may be in the case of standards I to X and a Principal or a teacher of Higher Secondary Course deputed to be in charge of Principal" shall be substituted;

(vi) for rule 18, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"18. When a teacher or Headmaster or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal is transferred from one school to another, whether under the same Educational Agency or a different Educational Agency, the Headmaster, Headmistress, Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be, of the former school shall forward a Last Pay Certificate in the prescribed form to the Headmaster, Headmistress, Vice-Principal or Principal, as the case may be, of the latter school, who shall make an entry relating to the date and time of the teacher's or Headmaster's or Headmistress's or Vice-Principal's or Principal's joining duty. In the case of Headmasters, Headmistresses, Vice-Principals and Principals as the case may be, the Last Pay Certificate shall be countersigned by the Educational Officer or such other officer authorised by the Government."



(vii) in rule 19, after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal" shall be inserted;

(viii) In rule 26,—

(a) after the word, "Headmaster" which occurs at both the places, the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal" shall be inserted;

(b) in clause (ii) of the Note, after the words "Educational Officer" the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted;

(ix) in rule 27, for the words "Headmaster may refer to the Educational Officer", the words "Headmaster or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal may refer to the Educational Officer or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be substituted;

(x) in the proviso to rule 28, after the words "Educational Officer" the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted;

(xi) in rule 29, after the words "Educational Officer" the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted;

(xii) (a) in rules 30, 31, 32 and 33, after the word "Headmaster" the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal or Principal as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(b) in rules 30, 32 and 33, after the words "Educational Officer", the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted;

(xiii) in rule 34, in clause (a), after the word "Headmaster" which occurs, at both the places, the words "or Headmistress or Vice-Principal" shall be inserted;

(xiv) in the second proviso to rule 43, after the word "Headmaster" the words and symbols "Headmistress, Vice-Principal" shall be inserted;

(xv) in sub-rule 44, in sub-rule (1) and in the Note thereto, after the words "Headmasters" and "Headmaster", wherever they occur the words "Headmistresses and Vice-Principals" and "Headmistress and Vice-Principal" shall respectively be inserted;

(xvi) in rule 44 A, after the words "Headmaster" and "Headmasters" wherever they occur the words and symbols "Headmistress, Vice-Principal" and "Headmistresses, Vice-Principals" shall respectively be inserted.

(xvii) in rule 44 B, after the words "Headmasters" and "Headmaster" wherever they occur the words and symbols "Headmistresses, Vice-Principals" and "Headmistress, Vice-Principal" shall respectively be inserted.



(xviii) in rule 45 C—

(a) in sub-rule (1),—

(i) for the words figures and letter. "Headmaster in accordance with the provisions contained in rule 44, 44 A", the words, figures and letter "Headmaster, Headmistress or Vice-Principal in accordance with the provisions contained in rule 44 and 44 A" shall be substituted;

(ii) after the words "under the Educational Agency as Headmaster", the words "Headmistress or Vice-Principal" shall be inserted;

(b) in the sub-rule (5), in the proviso, for the words "in the case of Headmaster of Aided High Schools" the words and symbol "in the case of Headmaster, Headmistress and Vice-Principal of Aided High School" shall be substituted;

(xix) in rule 49, in the Explanation, for the words "Teacher-in-charge also" the words and symbols "Teacher-in-charge, Headmistress, Vice-Principal also" shall be substituted;

(xx) for rule 57, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"57. The Headmaster/Headmistress/Vice-Principal shall be the competent authority to grant casual leave to teachers in standards I to X in schools having Standards I to XII. In such schools the Principal shall be the competent authority to grant casual leave to teachers of Higher Secondary Course and non-teaching staff of the school. The Educational officer or such other officer authorised by the Government shall be the competent authority to grant casual leave to Headmaster/Headmistress/Vice-Principal/Principal as the case may be. A copy of the application for casual leave of the Headmaster/Headmistress/Vice-Principal/Principal shall be submitted to the Manager for information." ;

(xxi) in rule 58,—

(a) after the word "Headmaster" and "Headmasters" wherever they occur, the words and symbols "Headmistress/Vice-Principal/Principal and Headmistresses/Vice-Principals/Principals as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(b) after the words "Educational Officer" wherever they occur, the words "or such other officer authorised by the Government" shall be inserted;

(xxii) in rule 61,

(b) in sub-rule (3), for the word “Headmaster” the words and symbols “Headmaster/Headmistress/Vice-Principal/Principal” shall be substituted;
