Government are pleased to order that the Revised Syllabus for the Basic Training Programme to Sub Inspector Cadets in the Kerala Police Force furnished by the State Police Chief, Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram, is approved and appended herewith.

Additions and Deletions

| 1 | Zero weeks are (6 days) deleted and the training will be started from the very first day itself. |
| 2 | 34 days allotted for POP rehearsal, examinations, contingency is deleted. The examinations will be conducted during the periods allotted for each subjects/papers. 50 periods are allotted for POP rehearsal separately. |
| 3 | 3 days out of 34 days are allotted for the Mid training break. So that three training breaks of 3 days each during the basic training can be provided. Hence the total number of days for the mid training break is 9 days. |
| 4 | 6 days allotted to the Zero week is added with the training days. |
| 5 | Saturdays are full working days and the periods are re-allotted to various indoor and outdoor subjects. |
| 6 | 31 days out of 34 days and another 45 days are allotted for the attachment training. So that the total attachment is for two and half months during basic training period itself. |
| 7 | The duration of period is re-scheduled as 45 minutes. Thus the total number of periods is 2332 {1272 periods for indoor (212×6) and 1060 periods for outdoor (212×5)}. |
| 8 | The total training periods for indoor subjects are 1111 instead of 1260. |
| 9 | 6 new topics and gender sensitisation from the sensitisation module are added to capsule course. The total period for capsule course is 236 instead of 300. The periods allotted to various topics are re-scheduled as per the importance of various subjects. |
| 10 | The sensitisation module is deleted as the topic incorporated with this is already there in the various subjects. |
| 11 | For outdoor subjects 1060 periods are allotted instead of 785 periods. Out of 1060 periods 150 periods are allotted for personal maintenance and Sramadhan (in all Thursdays), 55 periods for Disaster management, 20 periods for First Aid (for capsule courses) and 20 periods for Directors assessment. |

12	A total of 400 marks is fixed for the capsule courses altogether and marks for the Directors' assessment is reduced to 25 from 100 Marks. Hence the total marks for entire subject is fixed as 2400.
13	The total periods allotted for Directors' assessment is reduced into 20 from 55 periods.
14	An additional period of 50 is allotted for the POP rehearsal in the outdoor training program and 150 periods for Sramadhan and personal maintenance (in all Thursdays).
15	Thus the total periods for the outdoor training are re-scheduled as 1060 instead of 785 periods.
16	The periods allotted for indoor subjects and outdoor subjects are re-scheduled by considering the importance of each subject and for allotting periods for newly added topics.

Within the period of Basic Training, the SI Cadets will be attached to various Police and Non-Police Organizations in order to improve their Physical, Psychological and Social capacities which enable them to become efficient Police Officers in all aspects with the expectation of the Society as well as the department. In the present scenario, to tackle with the changing crime trend become a meticulous effort to the Police Force, especially for the SHOs who are the backbone and cutting edge of the Police Force. In order to resolve these menaces, the upcoming Sub-Inspector trainees should be attached with various Law enforcement organizations, who impart professional training in a scientific manner for a period of Two and half months.

-Thus the entire training including basic training, attachments and four months practical training will be completed by 16 months instead of 22 months. After 16 months they will be posted as SHOs in various police stations.

- Note 1:** Examinations in Papers 1,2,3,4,5,6,7, & 8 will be held by Examiners selected by a Board appointed by the IG of Police In Charge of the Training Wing of the Police Department
- Note 2:** Examination in papers 9 and 10 will be held by a Board appointed by the Head of the Training Institution.
- Note 3:** The training of those who fail to pass in all subjects by the end of the Course will be extended by 3 months after which they will be examined in the subjects in which they fail. If they fail again, one more chance will be given after 3 months during which no stipend will be paid. Those who fail even after the second extension will be discharged.
- Note 4:** The Examination can be held at different times for different papers of topics at any time after the prescribed contents for the paper/topic has been adequately taught. The examination in a topic does not have to be at the end of the training period.
- Note 5:** During the course as many mid-term or unit tests may be conducted by the head of the training institutions as may be found reasonable and convenient.
