The desired Certificate is as follows:

1. No. of Institutions already existing in the State: 30 (9 Govt. Medical Colleges + 1 Co-Operative Medical College + 1 Medical College under Deemed University + 19 Private Unaided Self Financing Medical Colleges)
2. No. of seats available or No. of doctors being produced annually : 3600
3. No. of doctors registered with the State Medical Council: 37845
4. No. of doctors in Government service: 6363
5. No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural /difficult areas: 1200
6. No. of doctors registered with Employment Exchange: 434
7. Doctors population ratio in the State: 1:2305
8. The No. of doctors being produced annually now is not sufficient enough to meet the ever increasing demand of the literate population of Kerala. Secondly, more number of brilliant students who are unable to get admission locally go to the neighbouring States and get admission paying hefty capitation fee. Thirdly, there are 434 numbers of vacancies in the Government Health sector as of now. Fourthly, there is a need for reducing the ratio among the population and the no. of doctors.
9. As of now, only students domiciled in the State are given admission in the Government Medical Colleges. However, certain number of seats are earmarked for allocation under the Central Pool. The question of imposing restriction on students who are not domicile in the State will be decided as per the existing guidelines of Government of India and the Medical Council of India.

10. The area in which the applicant desires to establish Medical College requires such an institution of this kind. There is a demand for better medical facilities and medical professions as well.
11. Doctor-patient ratio proposed to be achieved 1:800
12. This Certificate is valid for the academic years 2017-2018 & 2018-2019.

The Director, Sree Ayyappa Medical College and Research Foundation, Vadasserikkara, Pathanamthitta District, Kerala has applied for establishment of a Medical College in Pathanamthitta District. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Kerala has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical College with 150 seats.

It is certified that:-

- (a) The applicant owns and manages a hospital which was established at Pathanamthitta District.
- (b) It is desirable to establish a Medical College in the public interest.
- (c) Establishment of a Medical College at Pathanamthitta District by the Sree Ayyappa Medical College and Research Foundation is feasible.
- (d) The Essentiality Certificate is issued on condition that all clinical materials as per Medical Council of India norms will be made available in the hospital within the stipulated time as fixed by the Medical Council of India.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical Colleges as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.

Kind attention of Government is invited to the references cited.

An inspection was conducted from this Department in the proposed Medical
College at Vadasserikkara in Pathanamthitta District on 29.10.2021 and the
summary of the said report is as follows:-

1. Adequate space is available, but much more construction and furnishing
of infrastructure needed to start a new Medical College.
2. Only basic equipments are available in the Hospital. Facilities and
equipment lacking in Central Sterile Supply Department, Blood Bank,
central labs etc.
3. Available clinical material on the day of inspection is grossly inadequate.
4. Faculty position is grossly inadequate.
5. Even though the hospital is said to function, the statistics were not made
available during the inspection.

In this connection, I may inform Government that it will be difficult to start the proposed Medical College in the coming academic year as the minimum requirements stipulated by National Medical Commission for issuing Letter of Permission is not at all fulfilled. The Medical College and Collegiate Hospital attached to the College require a lot of further important developments.

(A) For Teaching Faculty:
(a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Prof & Tutor in respective department shall be counted together.
(b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
(c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. eg. (d) Any excess/extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR Eg: excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR
