Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Board of Revenue for the State of Kerala was constituted under the Kerala Board of Revenue Act 1957 (Act 7 1957). The circumstances under which the Board of Revenue was constituted have since changed very much and in the interest of the Administration of the State, as per the Board of Revenue Abolition Act, 1996 the Board of Revenue will be abolished from the date notified by Government. Government have now decided the first day of July 1998 as the date from which the Board of Revenue Abolition Act shall come into force. It is necessary to issue notifications for entrusting the powers now exercised and performed by the Board of Revenue and the Members of the Board of Revenue under the various enactments to the Government and other appropriate authorities as may be specified by the Government.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.

ORDER

The question of re-organisation of the Revenue Department was engaging the attention of the Government for sometime past. As per the Government Order read as-1st paper above, the Board of Revenue was abolished. Government consider that it is the right time to re-organise the Land Revenue Department for strengthening the main line of administration in the Revenue Department.

2. Shri P. R. Radhakrishna Pillai Commission, who was entrusted with the study of the Land Revenue Administration to find out the idle offices in the Land Revenue Department, and the Commissioner of Land Revenue have identified certain number of posts on various categories and recommended for re-deployment of these posts with a view to strengthen the revenue administration and the formation of new officers for improving

the revenue collections. The Commissioner of Land Revenue has therefore forwarded detailed proposals for restructuring the administration of the Land Revenue Department. Accordingly a total of 1,812 posts as detailed below, are necessary for the formation of new offices.

Details of offices/sections to be formed as part of the re-organisation of the Land Revenue Department is consolidated and shown in Annexure-II of this order.

3. For this purpose, Shri Radhakrishna Pillai, Commission and the Commissioner of Land Revenue have suggested to abolish the temporary offices shown in Annexure-III of this order and to re-deploy the staff of these offices (1,768 posts). The Commissioner of Land Revenue have recommended to down-grade the Office of the Special Deputy Collector, Newsprint Project, Vaikom as Special Tahsildar Office by creating a post of Tahsildar and Attender. Accordingly one post of Deputy Collector will also be available for re-deployment. The Commissioner of Land Revenue have also recommended to re-deploy the following 87 posts for the formation of the new offices/sections.

Accordingly a total of 1151 posts as detailed in Item (4) of Annexure I are available for re-deployment, for the formation of new offices.

4. The proposal for the re-organization was examined by the Government in detail, on the basis of Sri Radhakrishna Pillai Commission Report and in consultation with the Commission of Land Revenue and Government hereby issue the following orders:—

(i) The temporary Offices shown in Annexure III of this order are hereby abolished.

(ii) The following posts which are available as a result of the abolition of the temporary offices are re-deployed for the formation of new offices/sections as detailed in Annexure II of this order.

5. Consequent on the abolition of Board of Revenue, Government desires to delegate the powers in the Revenue Department down to the level of Village Officers. Since the Village Officer is functioning at the cutting edge level of the Government administration, Government consider it necessary that the posts of the Village Officers have to be upgraded to that of Head Clerk/Revenue Inspector commensurating with additional responsibility. Government therefore order that the post of Village Officer will be upgraded to that of Head Clerk/Revenue Inspector on the scale of pay of Rs. 1400-2300. Village Officers/Upper Division Clerks who are drawing salary in the scale of pay of Rs. 1400-2300 only will be posted as Village Officers in the above upgraded post. *Cited*

6. The Commissioner of Land Revenue will deploy the 1786 posts which are available (by re-deployment and creation) as detailed in Annexure IV of this order.

7. This order will take effect from 1st November 1998 so that the Commissioner of Land Revenue will complete the statutory and administrative formalities for winding up the offices and creating new Sections.
