On December 8, 2014, the Deputy Speaker announced that clause by clause consideration of The Kerala Maritime Board Bill, 2014 have been postponed to another day.

Rulings by the Deputy Speaker

On December 3, 2014, the Deputy Speaker gave ruling that after examining the evidences against the Minister for Finance, Law and Housing in the Compact Discs submitted by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan, permission is denied for laying of the discs on the Table as it contains nothing more than those visuals already telecasted in the visual media.
