Question of Breach of Privilege:

(a) On December 21, 2000 Speaker withheld consent to the following notices of question of breach of privilege given under Rule 135.

(1) Notice given by Shri K. T. Kunthammed against Shri Petingamala Ramachandran, Printer and Publisher, Mangalam Daily alleging that the news published under the title "കമ്മ്യൂണിക്കേഷൻ കമ്മിറ്റി, സംഭവങ്ങൾ" was aimed at defaming the Legislature Committee.

(2) Notice given by Shri K.G. Joseph against Shri A. Surendran, S.P., Vigilance and Anticorruption Bureau alleging that the action of the latter asking Shri M. M. Hassan to report to his office in connection with the inquiry of a case is inconsistent with the constitution and violation of the Rules of Procedure.

APPENDIX VI

SALIENT FEATURES OF BILLS PASSED DURING THE
FIFTEENTH SESSION1. **THE KERALA SPORTS BILL, 1999**

The activities for the promotion of sports and games in the State are now carried out by the Kerala Sports Council registered under the Travancore Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act, 1955 (Act XII of 1955). Government had entrusted an Expert Committee to study and submit a report on the measures to be adopted for the promotion of sports. The said committee has submitted its recommendations which give emphasis on the concept of "Sports for all" and the Government have considered the same in detail.

2. Government have decided to enact a law for the constitution of sports council at State level, district level and local level, aiming at the development of sports and games ensuring greater participation of the public in it, and also to invest such council with special powers and functions.

3. This Bill is intended to achieve the above object.

2. **THE KERALA APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2000**

The Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 204 (1) of the Constitution of India, read with Article 205 thereof, to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala required to meet the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala and the grants made by the Legislative Assembly for the expenditure of the Government of Kerala for the financial year 2000-2001.
